**RECEIVER’S NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE OF HIS
MOTION FOR AN EXPEDITED ORDER COMPELLING
DEFENDANT JARED RICE SR. TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE**

The Receiver’s Motion for an Expedited Order Compelling Defendant Jared Rice Sr. to Appear and Show Cause (the “Motion”) [ECF No. 25] sought the return of 75,539 PIVX coins that had been withdrawn from an AriseBank account just as the Receiver attempted to take possession of them. The Receiver believes he has now recovered all or substantially all of the original 75,539 PIVX coins that were the subject of the Motion, some in the form of U.S. currency derived from the sale of a portion of the PIVX coins. In addition, Mr. Rice appears to have complied with the commitments he made under oath and on the record at the February 9, 2018 hearing, including filing an accounting on February 15, 2018, which he has committed to update further, and appearing for his deposition on February 27, 2018. Accordingly, the Receiver respectfully withdraws his Motion without prejudice and requests that the Court cancel the continuation of the hearing on the Motion set for March 1, 2018 [ECF No. 39]. The Receiver

reserves the right, however, to renew his Motion and request a new hearing if he discovers new facts or if circumstances otherwise change.
