**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO ENTER JUDGMENTS AS TO DEFENDANTS RICE AND
FORD AND NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENTS**

Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) files this Unopposed Motion to Enter Judgments As To Defendants Jared Rice and Stanley Ford, and would respectfully show the Court as follows:

1. On January 25, 2018, the SEC filed its Complaint and Motion for Temporary Restraining Order alleging that the Defendants engaged in various violations of the federal securities laws. Dkt. 2, 6-7. On the same date, the Court ordered temporary restraining orders against all Defendants, an asset freeze, and the appointment of a receiver over Defendant AriseBank. Dkt. 11-12. The Court subsequently entered a preliminary injunction against each Defendant. Dkt. 61, 69. Finally, on August 27, 2018—on joint motion of the SEC, Rice, and Ford—the Court stayed the case through November 30, 2018 to allow the five-member Securities and Exchange Commission to consider settlement offers from Rice and Ford.

2. Today the five-member Securities and Exchange Commission accepted the settlement offers.¹ As reflected in their Consents, Rice and Ford agree to the terms of the proposed Final Judgment, and further agree that it may be presented for entry by the Court without further notice. A copy of the executed Consents are attached as Exhibit A (Rice) and Exhibit B (Ford), and are being filed with Clerk simultaneously with this motion. Therefore, the SEC respectfully asks the Court to enter the proposed Final Judgment as to Rice and Ford.
